## HEALTH AND SAFETY REPRESENTATIVE STRUCTURE

The Tipping Foundation / VISTA and House with No Steps have proposed some changes to your Health and Safety Representative (HSR) structure. This affects your ability to advocate for a workplace that is safe and doesn't harm your health.

Please attend a meeting in your area to discuss the proposed changes and what it means for you and your colleagues. **Your attendance at the meeting will provide you with an opportunity to further learn about the role and importance of HSRs.** HSRs are a legislative requirement and are elected by workers such as yourself, they play a crucial and independent role in ensuring that your workplace is a safe place to work.

HACSU representatives will be formally writing to The Tipping Foundation (TTF) & House with No Steps (HWNS) senior management by no later than 20 July 2018.

To ensure that HACSU representatives are reflecting the needs of our membership, it is important that you attend a meeting in your area. The meeting times and places will be emailed to by both HACSU and TTF & HWNS, and we have included a printed copy.
