HACSU MEMBERS SUCCESSFULLY DEMAND DHHS PAY DESPITE DELAYS IN FORMAL APPROVAL PROCESS AT FAIR WORK COMMISSION

GREAT NEWS! Despite the new DHHS EBA not yet being certified by the Fair Work Commission, HACSU has successfully demanded that the DHHS pay the 3.5% pay increase that was scheduled for 1 July 2018. This means that the 19th July is a 3.5% BIGGER, BETTER PAY DAY!

The new rates will appear in your 19th July pay, along with backpay from 1st July 2018.
