

JULY 1 2018 WAGE INCREASES ATTENDANT CARERS



This chart details increases to the minimum award rates for staff classified as Attendant Carers. These rates are per the Social Community Home Care and Disability Services (SCHADS) Award. The July rate is an increase of the National Minimum Wage, as determined by the Fair Work Commission each year.

If your employer is bound by the Attendant Care Pre-Modern Award - Victoria, you will be subject to different pay rates to the SCHADS Award. The details are below.
