Nominations cannot be withdrawn after this time. As per the registered rules of the Union, nominees must be a member of the relevant Branch.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Organisation's rules prior to lodging nominations.

## **Candidate Statements and Photographs**

Candidates may submit a statement and passport sized photograph to be included with ballot material. Only statements and photographs which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer with the candidate's nomination form not later than 12 noon AEST on 19/06/2019 can be accepted. Statements and photographs are preferred in Word and jpeg format respectively, submitted by email to vicelections@aec.gov.au

#### Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 25/07/2019 and close at 12 noon AEST on 22/08/2019.

#### **Scrutineers**

As per the registered rules of the Union, candidates are entitled to appoint a Scrutineer who may be present at all stages of the ballot. The appointment of scrutineers opens on 05/06/2019 and closes 12 noon AEST 19/06/2019. A Scrutineer appointment form is available from the Returning Officer.
