Restrictions on Visitors

Announced yesterday, as of midnight on 07th April 2020, there are now restrictions on visitors to HACSU members' workplaces, including the following:

- Hospitals
- Disability group homes
- Alcohol and drug services
- Residential care facilities
- Secure welfare services

The Victorian Government had advised that no one must not enter any of the above care facilities unless they are:

- A resident
- A staff member or
- Are visiting a resident of the facility (in limited circumstances)

Visits are to be limited to one visit per day, for a maximum of two hours and with no more than two people at one time.
