Night shifts commencing 21/09 or 22/09 paid at PH rates for the entire shift, as the majority of the shift falls on a PH. PH rates do not apply if beginning work on the PH, but the majority of the shift is not a PH.

#### **Health & Allied Services**

If the PH falls on a rostered day off, 150% rates apply or by agreement, TIL/additional leave at 150%.
